



Multi-chamber system for maximum rigidity of the double roller carriage.



Crosscut fence: for accurate crosscutting. Cutting range: 95 – 3200 mm.

mounted on riving knife with extraction socket

LEFT OF THE SAW BLADE:

Precise robustly mounted crosscut fence
for simple setting and accurately reproducible 90°
Perfectly square connection of cross slide to sliding table
Flip stops with bilateral mountings clamp rightly
to securely hold the set dimension
Easily removable cross slide
One-sided mitre fence, +/- 45°





Large extraction hood, laterally adjustable, max. saw blade diameter of 400 mm.



DUPLEX: double-sided mitre fence for cutting any angle between 0 and 90° very quickly and easily.



STEG: second support on the sliding table (width 400 mm).



RAPIDO: shimless scoring system. Adjustment range 2.8 – 3.8 mm.



SLIDING TABLE CUTTING LENGTHS

Sliding table length	With or without scoring saw blade

These cutting lengths refer to mechanical travel, i.e. from end stop to end stop on the sliding table.



Technical specifications.

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Trimming and ripping



The clamping shoe secures the board on the double roller carriage.



Align and trim the material along the cutting line.



Guide the workpiece along the rip fence and over the rotating saw blade, using the push stick if necessary.

Sizing



Make a square cut.



Position the rip fence in front of the saw blade, set to the required length and cut.



Cut the remaining piece to size on the crosscut fence.


Chamfering and concealed cuts



Fix the workpiece under the clamping shoe and cut the chamfer.



Set the height of the blade and the width on the rip fence.



Set the height of the riving knife to 2 mm below the top of the saw blade teeth and position the rip fence behind the saw blade.



Squaring



Align the panel and make a trim cut.



Turn the panel anti-clockwise and place the trimmed edge against the fence.



Cut to square.

Dividing up and sizing



Cut panel strips on the rip fence.



Cut panel strips to final length on the rip fence.



Cut the remaining piece to size on the crosscut fence.

Angle and mitre cuts



Tilt the saw blade to the desired angle, lay the workpiece against the crosscut fence.



Bevel ripping on the rip fence with workpiece on the sliding table.



Mitre cut using one-sided mitre fence.



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
